

Nissan FAST Program

Note: These instructions are based on those posted on the Skyline Australia forum. Those instructions were geared towards people that have Skylines/Japanese model cars. I have adapted the instructions for people that have USDM vehicles. You can tailor the FAST setup for different types of vehicles, which will be covered later.

Installation

1. Download the FAST files. Depending on where you download them from there will be multiple “.rar” files. Here is a breakdown of what these files correspond to.
 - a. *Japanese Domestic Market vehicles:* A1, A2, A3, B1, B2
 - b. *General RHD and LHD :* GR, GL
 - c. *European Vehicles:* ER, EL1, EL2
 - d. *European RHS and LHD (Including U.S. Vehicles):* US Disc 1, US Disc 2
2. Once the files have been downloaded, extract them in the structure below. What you want to accomplish here is to have a C:\NISSAN folder, and a CD folder in that. Then extract each “.rar” files in its own folder (which corresponds to its name).
3. Run the file C:\NISSAN\CD\A1\FASTPRG\WIN32\SINKI\SETUP32.exe. The program will install itself in the C:\NISSAN directory.
 - a. *Note:* I have run into some problems using the US discs when FAST is installed from the files found in the A1 disc. If you will primarily be using the US discs, use the same installation files found in the US Disc 1.
4. When the setup completes, a configuration/setup window will appear. On this window, click the CD-ROM Setup button.
 - a. Here you can setup as many as 7 discs (or in our case folders in the “CD” directory).
 - b. Choose the discs you want according to the information they contain (covered in step one).
 - c. You may change this setup at any time by clicking the “FAST Setup” in the “FAST For Windows” folder in your start menu.
5. You can change other things if you want (Such as the font and script), if not, click “OK” to close the setup window.
6. Copy the file C:\NISSAN\CD\A1\FASTPRG\WIN\GR\NSFASTKY.ini to the C:\WINDOWS directory.
7. After copying the file to C:\WINDOWS, right-click on the file and click “Properties”. In the window that opens, uncheck the option that says “Read-Only”.
 - a. *Note:* Be sure you do this on the file in the C:\WINDOWS directory.
8. You can now start the FAST program using the “FAST for Windows” icon in the “FAST for Windows” folder in your start menu.

Using FAST

1. When you start FAST it may give you a window asking you what “database” you want to use. Choose the one that best suits your needs at the time (it will ask you each time you launch only if you have multiple databases/discs setup).
